### Changes to Lighting Codes for New Construction

On January 1, Maryland code changes for construction lighting and maximum lighting power density (LPD) levels took effect, which could reduce incentive amounts and energy savings. For exterior lighting, base lighting allowances have been lowered.

Code	Zone 1	Zone 2	Zone 3	Zone 4
90.1-2013	500W	600W	750W	1,300W
90.1-2016	350W	400W	500W	900W

The maximum LPD for specific spaces has also changed. For example, the maximum LPD for uncovered parking areas—90.1-2013—has been reduced from 0.04–0.13 W/sq. ft. to 0.03–0.08 W/sq. ft., depending on zone. Also, the maximum LPD allowed for certain building types has decreased significantly: a 29% reduction for garages and 27% reduction for warehouses.
