A preview of the major changes and new additions in the soon to be published 2022 FGI Guidelines Hospital and Outpatient editions. This talk will include a brief history of the Guidelines and their development process, and an overview of the hot topics and major changes in both the Guidelines for the Design

and Construction of Hospital and the Guidelines for Design and Construction of Outpatient Facilities. There will also be an update on the new Emergency Conditions Guidelines and FGI Beyond Fundamentals for these two facility types.

Mr. Uhaze a registered architect and has worked in the field of healthcare design for the past 40yrs. For 28 of those years he was employed by the State of New Jersey as the Authority Having Jurisdiction over the construction of every healthcare facility constructed in the state. While with the State of New Jersey, he served on numerous committees including the Barrier Free Committee, Fire Safety Committee, and the Codes Advisory Board.

He is a 25 year member of the Facility Guidelines Institute-Health Guidelines Revisions Committee, served as the Co-Chair of the Hospital Document Sub-committee, HGRC Vice Chairman of the 2018 edition and is the HGRC Chairman of the 2022 edition.

He is a frequent speaker throughout the Delaware Valley area as well as across the country and is currently providing consultation to the healthcare industry regarding the FGI Guidelines, NJ State Standards, NFPA Standards and the International Building Code.
